### TSAVO WEST

Full days enjoying the various activities that the camp has to offer 1 Day spent exploring Tsavo East National Park which achieved notoriety in the 1900's when 'the Man-eaters of Tsavo', a pair of rogue man-eating lions, preyed gruesomely on the builders of the Uganda Railway. Today the Park is more famous for the numerous prides of mane-less lion that patrol the plains and police the herbivore herd. Other wildlife highlights – vast herds of dust-red elephant, fat pods of hippo, giant crocodile, teeming herds of plains game, a fantasia of bird life and Meals and overnight at Kipalo Hills Camp LDBB

### VIPINGO - KURUWITU

Breakfast at the camp. Morning drive by road via Mombasa or Tsavo East to your hotel on the North Coast, a paradise of sand and bright blue sea. The Kenyan coast offers a colourful history. From the 9th century onwards, Indian and Arab traders mingled with the indigenous population to create the unique Swahili culture, much of which still survives until this day. The remains of many early Swahili settlements dot the coastline, the most significant being the 15th century Gedi ruins south of Malindi, while Lamu town has been designated a World Heritage Site due to its significance as a Swahili Centre. The coast also boasts unique and diverse habitats, both in maritime and terrestrial national parks and reserves. Meals and Overnight at Cardamom House
